
Camp Winston was the first place in my life where I felt accepted, not judged, and I was able to make friends

Camp Winston, located on the shores of Sparrow Lake, plays a crucial role in the lives of children with complex neurobiological disorders, such as Autism Spectrum Disorder, Tourette Disorder, ADHD, learning disabilities and many others.

For children with complex neurobiological disorders, life can be challenging – and they are often left out of social settings like school, sports and recreational programs, including summer camp.

At Camp Winston, children have the opportunity to escape their often difficult daily lives, connect with others in a way never before experienced, and build lifelong skills to better cope with the world around them.

Camp Winston offers summer programs for children ages 7-17, as well as respite weekends and support services throughout the year for families challenged by the daily pressures of raising children with neurobiological disorders. These programs and services also support grandparents raising grandchildren, and children being raised in alternative care.

Celebrating 30+ years of success, Camp Winston has become a recognized leader in supporting children with neurobiological disorders and has a uniquely compassionate approach that allows campers to feel safe and welcome enough to connect, belong and thrive, without fear of rejection.
